DUES ARE BEING ACCEPTED FOR 2026!!!

Membership Dues are now being accepted for 2026 and **must be paid by January 31, 2026**.

Dues are **\$125.00 plus \$12.50 for each work hour** that you **“do not”** have **“STAMPED”** by a Director, Club Officer, or Committee Chairperson, on your club membership card. Unlimited rifle range fees are **\$75.00** and unlimited archery fees are **\$75**. These fees do not include scheduled shoots. When you pay your dues, you **MUST present and surrender your membership card with your money. NO EXCEPTIONS!** **NEW MEMBERS** cannot buy their hours in their **first year of membership**. You **MUST** work your hours for the **first year of membership AND host or help with at least one dinner or club event!** If you do not meet this requirement, you will not be allowed to become an active member in the Maybee Sportsman Club. If you are putting your dues in the safe at the club, please include your **original membership card (NO COPIES)** and include the correct amount of money due in an envelope marked **“2026 Dues”** on the outside.
